Here are three key trends to keep an eye on.



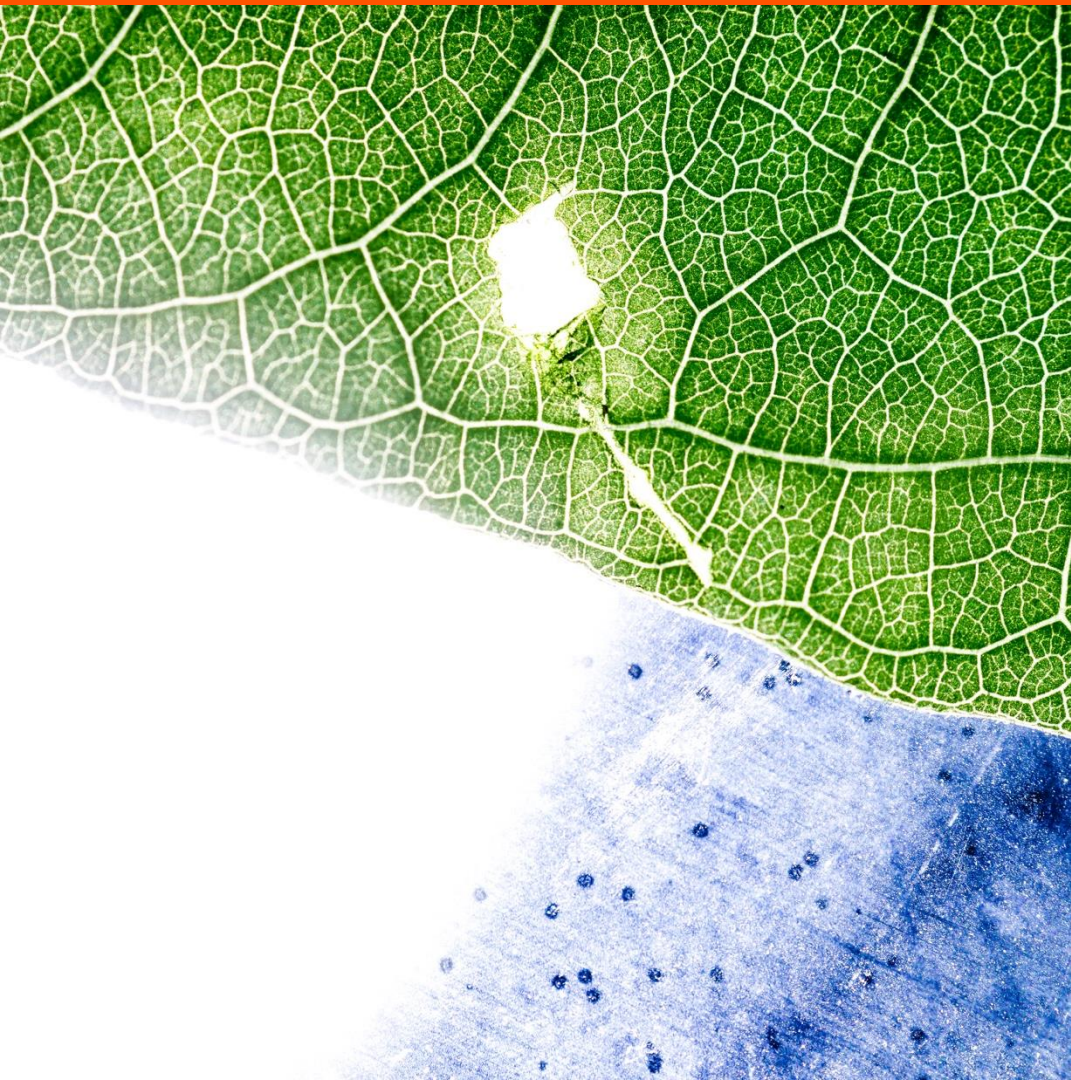
#1: Carbon-efficient construction work
